



## GRADUATE ORGAN SCHOLAR & MUSIC ASSISTANT

The Collegiate Church of St Mary and King's High School, Warwick seek to appoint a graduate Organ Scholar & Music Assistant for the academic year 2019-2020.

This is a new and exciting opportunity for someone with a keen interest in developing their musical skills in a liturgical setting as well as a passion for the education and musical development of young people.

The successful candidate will work in the Music Departments of St Mary's and King's High, and will be fully involved in the musical life of both. The post-holder will be expected to undertake reasonable administrative duties in both institutions. It is a full-time role (King's High term-time only), and will include duties over Christmas and Easter.

At St Mary's, the Organ Scholar will have the opportunity to play and conduct the choirs; help to train the choristers individually or in small groups, working on sight-reading skills, musicianship, and theory; and to take part in the regular recital series, among other things.

At King's High, the post-holder will assist in the many and varied duties of the Music Department, with a focus on accompanying soloists and ensembles. There may be further opportunities to take part in and to direct ensembles based on the post-holder's strengths and interests.

The combined post offers a salary of £12,500 per annum, and accommodation will be available at subsidised rent. Bills and utilities are to be paid by the occupant.

Direct experience of Anglican liturgy is not essential, but candidates must be in sympathy with the aims and ethos of the Church of England.

King's High, Warwick and St Mary's are committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment. The appointment will be subject to a satisfactory DBS check.
