Inspire and guide all special needs teams who seek to ensure that every child's needs are met within nurturing and inclusive learning environments. May they renew their life in you and grow in intimacy with God and each other.
Fri 10 Indonesia Mexico	Generous God, we give you thanks for the beauty of Warwickshire, with its wonderful historical buildings that attract visitors from all over the world. We pray for all who will be opening their doors for Heritage Open Days: bless and protect them as they share with all the structures and the stories they hold in trust.
<b>Sat II</b> Poland South Africa Ukraine Peru Netherlands Iraq	20 years since Al-Qaeda mounted terrorist attacks on key targets in the USA, we remember the 2,996 people killed, and pray for the 6,000 who were injured and thousands more worldwide whose lives have been reshaped indirectly by the repercussions. As the Imperial War Museum mounts exhibitions to mark the 20th anniversary, and many born since 9/11 now hear of its events for the first time, we renew our prayer for compassion, peace and reconciliation. During the moments of silence observed today, Lord, hear our prayer.
Sun 12 15 <sup>th</sup> Sunday after Trinity	Living Lord, who walks beside us all, we pray for those taking part in the Sky Walk raising funds for the orthopaedic team at Warwick Hospital. As they all Walk A Mile With A Smile, we give thanks for the team who mend broken bones and give patients with new hips and knees a new lease of life.
<b>Mon 13</b> Czechia Philippines Chile Canada	O God, our help in ages past, while people visit The National Memorial Arboretum's Greek Gardens this summer, we pray with veterans and families who attended Saturday's service to mark the 80 <sup>th</sup> anniversary of the 1941 Greek Campaign. We remember the people of Kalamata and veterans from the UK, Australia and New Zealand who fought that Greece might be free. May they always be remembered with honour, pride and gratitude.
