




# Weekly Newsletter

St Mary's seeks to be an inclusive church and welcoming to people of all ages and backgrounds. We have a carpeted area and pew bags available for the youngest members of our congregation, if they wish to use it. And they may like to take an adult with them! If you are a wheelchair user please speak to one of our sidespeople and they will happily move chairs to open up a space for you in the nave.

If you're a UK tax payer the money you place in the collection can be increased by around 25% if you fill out one of the blue or brown envelopes in the Nave chairs or by the main entrance. This allows us to retrieve the tax you've already paid and put it towards the work of St Mary's.

## 6<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2019 MARKS THE 75TH ANNIVERSARY OF D-DAY

The Allied invasion of Normandy, and the start of the liberation of Europe. Years of detailed planning led to the largest amphibious assault ever, and the Royal Warwickshire Regiment played its part with two battalions of infantry in what is termed the Normandy Campaign. It is fitting that these soldiers should be remembered and there is no better place for this than St Mary's Church. The Regiment is proud that its Association Standards are to be displayed within the Church, at the entrance to the Regimental Chapel from 6<sup>th</sup> June until 9<sup>th</sup> June. In 1963 the Regiment changed its name to the Royal Warwickshire Fusiliers and in 1968 merged into the Royal Regiment of Fusiliers. The Regiment Museum is situated at St John's House, Warwick.

**ROAD CLOSURES:** Junction improvements are taking place around the island at the end of Northgate Street. This will result in various road closures or re-directions in the vicinity: Barrack Street, The Butts, Cape Road, and Northgate Street. Northgate Street is not scheduled to be closed until August Bank Holiday weekend, but for access that weekend it would be helpful to know who will require access so we can make arrangements with the Council. Northgate Street will also potentially be closed on **Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> September** for a cycle race through the town; this is still to be confirmed. The provisional arrangements are that access to Northgate Street will be possible until 10.00am. There will be no parking in Northgate Street, but parking will be available in Church Street. You will be able to leave the Church after the service without any problem as the cycle race will not be using Church Street, only Northgate Street and Old Square.
